Flight Arrangements

You will need to make your own flight arrangements. America West Airlines, Southwest Airlines, and United Airlines fly into Tucson International Airport.

Time

The Border Institute will begin with a welcome lunch at 12:00 p.m. on Monday, April 28. The Institute will conclude at approximately 1:45 p.m. on Wednesday, April 30.

Resort Information

The conference will be held at the Rio Rico Resort & Country Club, 1069 Camino Caralampi, Rio Rico, Arizona (www.rioricoresort.com). The Resort is offering a block of rooms at a special rate of \$90.00 (plus tax and gratuity) per night for single or double occupancy. **The deadline for room reservations is April 11, 2003.** Reservation requests received after this date will be accepted on a space available basis only. Local Transportation

The Resort is 45 minutes away from the Tucson International Airport. Airport shuttle service is available through Arizona Stage Coach (www.azstagecoach.com) for \$75 (one-way group rate for 1-2 people) or \$100 (one-way group rate for 3 or more). *The cost will be split among the number of people per trip.* To arrange for shuttle transportation to the resort, please call Arizona Stagecoach directly at (520) 881-4111, fax (520) 881-6443, or email tmarlow1@mindspring.com. When making your reservation, indicate that you are part of the Border Institute V in order to facilitate a group discount.

If you rent an automobile, take I-19 South from the Tucson Airport. This freeway turns into R-19 South. Stay on it for approximately 45 minutes. You will exit on Exit 17. Make a right hand turn. You will see the Resort straight ahead.
